
Certified Cervical & Temporomandibular Therapist (CCTT) - CEU Policy – Category 1

Continuing Education Units (CEUs) are required for: **Applicants** applying for the CCTT Examination.

1. Category 1: Criteria for the 100 CEUs (Application Requirement)

Purpose:

Required for all applicants to sit for the CCTT Examination.

Timeframe:

- All 100 CEUs must be completed within the **10 years** prior to the application deadline (October 15 of the year applying).

Topic Requirements: these are the only topics allowed for application as it relates to this specialty certification.

- **Category 1A: Minimum 85 CEUs:** Must be specific to the specialty, including:
 - Cervical spine disorders
 - Temporomandibular disorders
 - Orofacial pain/dysfunction (including cervicogenic headache)
- **Category 1B: Maximum 15 CEUs:** May come from related topics such as:
 - Concussion
 - Dizziness / Vestibular
 - Sleep disorders/Airway
 - Facial palsy
 - Movement disorders of head & neck
 - Cancer-related dysfunction (head/neck)

Instructor Requirements For Continuing Education Courses:

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- All instructors must be healthcare professionals with a **4-year degree** from an accredited university.

Documentation Required:

- Course syllabus, description, or handouts.
- Clearly identify approved topics and number of CEUs for each topic.
 - On the syllabus, **highlight** the areas that apply to the credits you are counting for the specialty areas above (ie. cervical part of the syllabus with the hours spent during the course on that section alone).
- Certificate of Attendance/Completion showing:
 - Participant's name
 - Course name
 - Course date
 - Sponsor
 - Total CEUs awarded
